Duties include:

- Carry clinical and administrative supervisory responsibilities for 1-2 MST teams of 2-4 therapists each, including individual supervision as needed, weekly group supervision and training, assure availability of clinical /administrative support to clinicians 24 hours/day, 7 days/week
- Collaborate with stakeholders, both external in the community and within the provider agency & promote/educate about MST
- Generate and manage case referrals and manage clinician caseloads
- Collaborate actively with MST Expert around implementation of MST by the program, and to ensure continued development of own clinical skills and knowledge of relevant research
- Manage and report data on clinical outcomes and program practices
- Deliver MST to a caseload of 1-2 families, as required to address program needs

Education & Experience required:

- Master's degree in Psychology, Social Work, Counseling or a related subject area
- LCSW, LMFT, LPC, LCP Virginia licensure required
- Significant clinical experience in treating serious delinquent behavior in youth
- Direct use of pragmatic (i.e., structural, strategic and functional) family therapies

- Individual therapy with adolescents and adults using cognitive behavioral techniques, Marital therapy using behaviorally-based approaches, and Behavioral therapy targeting school behavior and academic performance
 - Implementation of interventions within or between systems in the youth's natural ecology that affect or influence the behavior of youth (i.e., family, peer, school, and neighborhood)
 - Provision of group and individual clinical supervision
 - Leadership role including hiring, performance evaluation, and holding supervisees accountable for performance
 - Training and collaboration with outside agencies
