Background & Highlights

Multisystemic Therapy (MST) is an evidence-based, intensive, family-focused therapy model which is demonstrated to be highly effective for youth with juvenile court involvement who are assessed as moderate or high risk to reoffend.

An Invitation to Negotiate (ITN) was issued on May 18th, 2017. Responses were reviewed by a committee of EBA and DJJ staff persons.

- Locations include:
 - Christiansburg

- Danville
 - Waynesboro
 - Woodstock
 - Pathways will begin hiring well-qualified therapists and supervisors in July.
 - A stakeholders meeting in each area will be held mid-August.
 - Therapists and Supervisors will receive MST model training in early September.
 - Teams will begin accepting DJJ referrals in mid-September.
